Standard Cleaning Guidelines

GENERAL:

The following cleaning guidelines may be used to clean the Canon imageRUNNER ADVANCE, imagePRESS, imageCLASS, varioPRINT 140/135 Series, and VarioPrint 6000 Series Products.

DETAILS:

Please follow the procedure below for guidelines on how to clean the mentioned products.

- 1) All areas frequently accessed by customers (i.e. control panels, covers and jam locations) may be cleaned with Isopropyl Alcohol using the following precautions:
 - a. Make sure device is powered down and unplugged before cleaning. Wait until surfaces are dry before plugging in and powering device back on.
 - b. Don't spray any cleaning agent directly onto the machine, instead spray the cleaning agent onto a lint free cloth/rag and then wipe surfaces.
 - c. Cloths/Rags should be disposed of after one use.
 - d. Use only glass cleaner on the platen glass surface and wipe with a lint free cloth.

The effectiveness of microbe sterilization should be confirmed by an expert in this area.

NOTE: Commercial wet wipes contain ingredients other than alcohol. Caution is required and recommendation is not possible. NOTE: This cleaning method does not guarantee effectiveness against any particular microbe. CAUTION: Alcohol is a flammable liquid and should never be used near fire or open flame.
